

Frequently Asked Questions

Solar Lamp

How do I switch to bright light mode?	To switch on the Solar Lamp and engage it on normal mode, press the “Power On” button once. To engage the Solar Lamp on bright mode, press the button twice.
How do I charge the Solar Lamp?	Keep the Solar Lamp in direct sunlight and the solar panel facing towards the sun, the Solar Lamp will start charging automatically.
How do I know the Solar Lamp is charging?	While charging, a small red light indicator next to the LED will glow.
Can I leave this Solar Lamp outside to charge when it is raining?	It is not recommended to keep the Solar Lamp exposed to rain, as the Solar Lamp is not waterproof.
Will the battery charge if the day is cloudy?	Yes, the Solar Lamp will charge when the day is cloudy but may take more time to get it fully charged.
How much time does the Solar Lamp requires to get fully charged?	The Solar Lamp requires about 8 hours of direct sunlight to get fully charged.
How long would the light last after a full charge?	The Solar lamp can last up to 6.5 hours on normal mode and 3 hours on bright mode.
How can the stand be used for setting different light angles?	You can keep the Solar Lamp on a flat surface and adjust the angle as required. You could even fit the semi-circle part of the stand on a water bottle neck which would give an extended height and wide lighting angle.
How do I get the best out of the equipment?	<p>You may adopt the following good practices:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fully charge the Solar Lamp before first use. • Charge the battery after every complete discharge. • Do not leave the battery in fully discharged state. • Recharge the battery at least once every 2 months when not in use. • Always keep the solar panel surface clean and avoid scratching it. • Keep Solar Lamp away from any fire or any corrosives. • Keep the Solar Lamp and charger in a dry and shaded place during charging. • Keep Solar Lamp away from any fire or any corrosives.
